### **Japanese 102, Elementary Japanese II (Spring)**

This course is continuation of Japanese 101. This course introduces students to Japanese using daily expressions and sentence patterns. It stresses communication with Japanese people. An introduction to the phonetic HIRAGANA and KATAKANA writing system is included. The use of video and audiotapes enriches the understanding of the Japanese language, culture, and way of thinking.

**Prerequisite: JAPANESE 101 or equivalent**

### **Japanese 202, Elementary Japanese IV (Spring)**

This course is continuation of Japanese 201. Students will learn more sentence patterns for communication in Japanese, and practice reading and writing of simple essays. The conversational component will be enhanced by the practicing skits and by the use of audio-visual media.
